# Minutes of the Steering Committee Meeting July 19<sup>th</sup> 2013

The meeting was chaired by Peter Wothers; minutes were recorded by Gabor Magyarfalvi.

- 1) Approval of the minutes from the January meeting
- 2) Discussion of rules for participation of new countries and possible changes in Regulations. The SC had a discussion on the topic on its mailing list. A text proposal was made by Gabor Magyarfalvi. The SC discussed the proposal and approved some changes. The change in the regulations will be put for a vote before the Jury.
- 3) Reports from observing countries
  - Liechtenstein: no students at IChO 45<sup>th</sup>. The SC has discussed the situation and future possibilities with the responsible persons.
  - Montenegro: a well-established national exam is in place, the team will come from the winners (cca. 30 schools participate).
  - Georgia: 2500 schools, a three-stage national Olympiad (2000 500 50 students)

Montenegro and Georgia are expected to participate in IChO 46 with a team.

## 4) Future Olympiads:

- 2014 Vietnam: SC meeting: Hanoi, January 9-12. Venues established. There will be a presentation to the Jury. A short information sheet will be circulated to mentors.
- 2015 Azerbaijan: There is full commitment. The Jury will vote at the 4<sup>th</sup> Jury meeting.
- 2016 There is no firm commitment yet at the moment.
- 2017 Thailand made a decision to host the IChO. A representative will be invited to SC meetings.
- 5) The Safety rules of the Regulations need to be updated to the new Globally Harmonized System of Classification of Chemicals. The changes are straightforward and will be put for a vote in the Jury.
