Dear Parent

I need to let you know about an unfortunate incident that took place during the Sixth Form Geology Field Trip to Tenerife at the very end of last term. The incident involved a number of students breaking curfew to go out to a local bar. For a small number of students, matters were made considerably worse when a small amount of drugs were bought from a local dealer. The teachers who oversaw the trip are to be commended for the excellent care that they provided the students and for investigating the misdemeanour quickly and thoroughly. I fear that you may well have read about this story in the media and want to be the first to tell you that having now concluded the investigation, I have taken firm, fair and proportionate action to punish the offending students.

I have spoken to the parents of all of those involved and am very grateful for the support they have given me in dealing appropriately with this difficult issue. Please be assured that I will continue to take a very hard line when it comes to drugs and their impact on our school community. We have a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health & Economic Education – or PHSEE – programme which, as you would expect, educates our students about the dangers of alcohol and drugs, and we will continue to promote it vigorously.
