#### **SCHOOLSTORY**

In the last year, 478 pupils were suspended from the school in south-east England by the head teacher. That's two pupils a day, and that's a quarter of all the 1,880 pupils at the school.

Bad behaviour is not allowed at Ms. Haynes's school. "Pupils come to school to learn," she says. "We will not tolerate anything that disrupts the learning process."

Who came up with this idea? Actually, the pupils. They wanted to learn but their lessons were being disrupted. "All the students, even the naughty ones, said they wanted to be in a school with strong discipline," says Ms. Haynes. What are the new rules?

- 1. A pupil who uses bad language to a teacher is suspended for five days.
- 2. A pupil who disrupts a class twice in one day is suspended.
- 3. Chewing gum, body piercings, mobile phones and MP3 players are not allowed in school.
- 4. Any pupil who brings drugs or weapons to school is permanently excluded.

While pupils are suspended, they have to do a homework task. They also have to go to a meeting with their parents and the Head teacher.

Has it worked? "Yes," says Ms. Haynes. "Exam results have soared. I am very proud." When Ms.. Haynes came to the school in 2004, 48% of pupils got 5 GCSEs. Four years later, 71% got 5 GCSEs.
